

BLENDER WENCH'S PUB CRAWL ROUTE

So you can drink as much as you can at as many places as you can!

This route is only a SUGGESTION for the faire/renn/pirate community. With so many venues and several locations being so small, let's try to co-raid more than one tavern at a time in order to help with crowd control (and be served in a more timely manner!) There are a few participating sites not on the route, but are great little spots to visit, as well! The last raid location is not participating in offering drink specials, but it is a fun place pirates have really enjoyed past invasions. That spot will be visited after the "official" pub crawl ending time at 11:00. In order to frequent as many locations as possible, it is suggested to spend approx. 45 minutes at each raid.



Meeting Place

- Meeting at Broadway Square at 6:00. After the ship battle
- If you would rather sail, check out the Schooner Woodwind (6pm sailing cruise), off of the Broadway Pier. Offering \$3 Clipper City beers.
- If you choose to take advantage of drink and food specials, it is suggested you register.

Route Directions

- Start at Broadway Square, face water
- RAID 1: Turn right, go down Thames. Pubs on the right
- RAID 2: Turn right at the corner of Bond. Pub in the left
- RAID 3: Exit pub, go left. Turn right on Aliceanna until you reach Broadway. Pubs on right, along Broadway
- RAID 4: Continue down Broadway on right
- RAID 5: Turn left at Thames. Pubs on left
- RAID 6: Back-track towards Broadway, pub along pier after water taxi

* BW Note: this was Edgar Allen Poe's favorite tavern and the last place he was seen alive. Some say his spirit still lingers....

Duda's Tavern

1600 Thames

\$3 Clipper City drafts, \$2 Grape Shots, \$1 Cannonball Sliders, 1/2 priced appetizers

* BW Note: they have awesome crab cakes (not discounted)

Raid #2 (7:00 – 7:45)

One Eyed Mike's, 708 South Bond Street

\$3 Clipper City and Cider

* BW Note: An Invasion Favorite!!! This is the only place offering cider discounts. This stop may fill up quick! If so, move on to one of the many taverns on Raid #3 or check out some of the alternative ports. This really was a pirate bar back in the day, and still has all period original woodwork around the bar.

\$2 Clipper City, \$5 Grey Goose shots, \$3 rails

\$3 Clipper City drafts

Raid #4 (9:00 – 9:45)

Alexander's Tavern, 710 South Broadway

\$3 Clipper City, \$4 Cherry and Grape Bombs, \$3 rail drinks plus \$2 off pizza and sliders

* BW Note: AWESOME drink specials!!

The Greene Turtle, 722 South Broadway

\$3 Clipper City Gold and Loose Cannon

* BW Note: One of the larger venues

Bertha's, 734 South Broadway

\$3 Clipper City from a Firkin, 1/2 priced appetizers or a free appetizer with purchase of entree (limit one per person, excludes mussels)

* BW Note: A Baltimore Landmark

Raid #5 (10:00 – 11:30)

* BW Note: Things starting to get a little fuzzy yet??? This raid is a little longer with so many taverns to frequent!

* BW Note: A great little Irish bar with lots of character! Used to be a brothel back in the day.

John Steven, Ltd, 1800 Thames Street

\$3 Clipper City drafts plus 50% off steamed shrimp, clams and mussels

FINAL Raid #6 (11:45 - ??)

Shuckers, 1629 Thames Street

Back on Broadway Square, next to the water

* BW Note: A past favorite, a large venue with fun music for joyful pirates to get their groove on!

Alternative Ports-Of-Call

Whistling Oyster, 807 South Broadway

\$3 Loose Cannon plus \$0.75 oysters

* BW Note: A good alternative if you want to break away between Raid 4 and 5

Ale Mary's, 1939 Fleet Street

\$3 Clipper City

* BW Note: A quaint little place – it may be out of the way, but they are loyal participants. Why not take a raiding party to check it out during Raids #5 or 6?

Red Star, 906 S. Wolfe Street

\$3 Clipper City drafts

* BW Note: This is off the beaten path, but a very large venue. Would work in between Raid #5 and 6
